Summer skiing...

(great for birthday parties & camps or path finders)

Here's what you need:

- 2 wooden planks (ca. 1m long & 10cm wide)
- 8 about 15cm lengths of rubber band
- a couple of small nails

Here's how it works:

Nail the lengths of rubber band to the planks, with a spacing of about 40 cm., so that "bows" materialise, into which you can put your feet. (they have to be fairly durable.)

Then you need 3 friends and a good technique to get going with your summer skis ☺.(Remember: "Vorsprung durch Technik"!!) ☺

If you make two sets you can compete with each other and have a race. Enjoy!



Skiing is like....listening to God's command:
